Add BONDERITE C-AK 5975 A AERO at 20% by volume to tap water and mix thoroughly.

Applications:

Apply water/BONDERITE C-AK 5975 A AERO solution by means of a non-atomizing spray or by conventional foamers. Allow sufficient time for solution to work. Rinse with high-pressure cold water or air/water rinser. Steam may also be used to rinse heavily soiled equipment.

Note:

BONDERITE C-AK 5975 A AERO can be applied between 5° to 45°C. Optimum temperatures have been found to be from 20° to 30° C.
